Informal discussion (with friends)	Can express his / her ideas and opinions with precision, and present and respond to complex lines of argument convincingly.																					
Sustained monologue: Describing experience	Can give elaborate descriptions and narratives, integrating sub-themes, developing particular points and rounding off with an appropriate conclusion.																					
Spoken interaction	Can discuss advantages and disadvantages, and support his / her arguments with reasons.																					
Spoken production	Can speculate about pictures, statements, or the answers to questions.
