

Meal times and opening hours in the UK

in the UK people usually start work between 8.30 and **9.00** a.m. Some people have breakfast at home but a lot of **people** just buy a coffee and something to eat when they go to work.

Most people work five days a week. The typical working day is seven or eight hours with a very short lunch (about half an bour) at about 1.00 p.m. People don't go home for lunch – they just have a sandwich in a café or sandwich bar, or in their office. People usually finish work at 5.00 or 5.30. They have dinner between 7.00 and 8.00 and this is usually the big meal of the day. During the week they usually go to bed between 10.30 and 11.30 p.m.

People go shopping after work or at the weekend. Some shops close early during the week (5.30-6.00 p.m.) but supermarkets and a lot of shops open until 8.00 in the evening or later. Big shops also open on Sunday, and big supermarkets open 24 hours a day, six days a week.
