

- Present to past:


(wasn't = was not)

- I don't have / go / get \rightarrow I didn't have / go / get NOT I didn't went

- verbs with final e = +d, e.g. change \rightarrow changed verbs with final consonant + y = y + ied, e.g. $cry \rightarrow cried$ verbs with final consonant / vowel / consonant = double final consonant + ed, e.g. $stop \rightarrow stopped$, $prefer \rightarrow preferred$


