- Don't contract *there is* in short answers, e.g. *Yes, there is*. NOT *Yes, there's*.

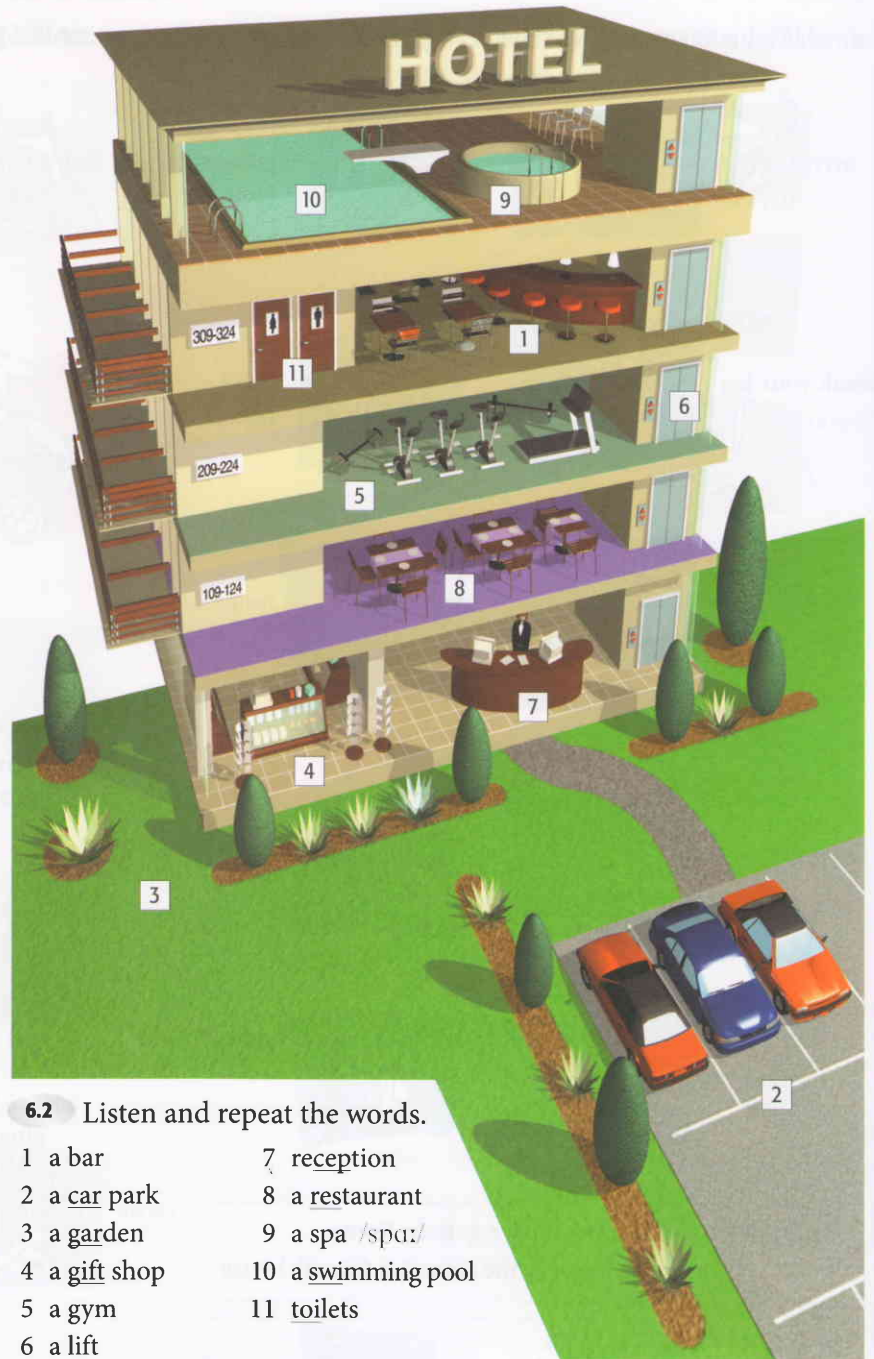
