fly	She doesn't like flying.	
cycle	He loves cycling.	∕ + <i>ing</i>
swim	We like swimming.	one vowel + one consonant =
	He doesn't like shopping.	double consonant + <i>ing</i>

⚠ Don't double final *x* and *w*, e.g.
boxing, snowing NOT ~~boxxing, snowwing~~

Are they going to swim?	Yes, they are.	No, they aren't.

- Use *be + going to + verb* to talk about future plans.
- You can use future time expressions, e.g. *tomorrow, next week, etc.*
