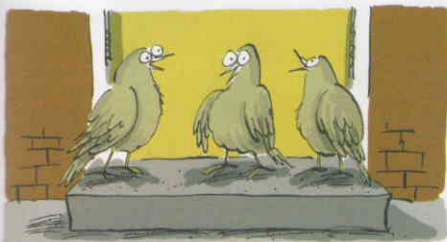

Are they going to swim?	Yes, they are.	No, they aren't.

- Use *be + going to + verb* to talk about future plans.
- You can use future time expressions, e.g. *tomorrow, next week, etc.*
