



**Description** Students review activities vocabulary from the lesson by doing a crossword

**Time** 10 minutes

**Extra material** Print out and photocopy the What do you like doing? worksheet – one for each student

# Instructions

- a Give each student a copy of the 'What do you like doing?' worksheet. Explain to SS that the number(s) in brackets after each clue represents the number of letters in each answer. Tell SS that they can work individually or in pairs to complete the crossword. Pre-teach / elicit across and down.
- **b** After SS have finished ask them to compare answers. Review answers with the class.


### **Answers**


